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A LEADER AT SUMMIT LIFE CHURCH SHOULD BE...

1. A CHRISTIAN

Our ultimate goal is to glorify God, leading others to Him, and helping others grow in Him. Therefore, our leaders should have a personal relationship with Christ themselves! (John 3:16)

2. <u>ACTIVE</u>

Leaders must be active in church attendance and involvement; not only in the area of service but also the regular worship services and other church events. (Heb. 10:25)

3. **UNITY**

Our leaders are expected to be aligned with our church theological, practically, and relationally. If there is an issue that arises between the leader and staff or a leader and an individual in the church the leader is expected to address that issue privately with the parties involved. Protecting the unity of the church. (Col. 4:6; 1 Peter 4:11; Eph. 5:4; Matt. 12:36)

4. AN EXAMPLE

Our leaders are expected to be examples and a positive influence on those they serve and lead. They should refrain from activities in their daily lives that do not glorify or honor God. In "gray areas" leaders should be sensitive to the convictions of others in both their actions and conversation. In their personal lives, leaders should be committed to Bible study, prayer, and Christ-like living. (Titus 2:6-7; 1 Cor. 6:19-20; Heb. 13:17)

5. **FAITHFUL**

When leaders give their word, they keep it. If a leader has committed to do something, or be somewhere, they follow through on it and are on time. If they are unable to fulfill their commitments, they communicate that as soon as possible so that those affected can take necessary action. (1 Cor. 4:2; Prov. 28:20)

6. <u>PURE</u>

Leaders are expected to pursue a life that is "above reproach". This includes being willing to be subjected to a background check pending ministry policies. (I Timothy 2:9; 5:1, 22; Eph. 5:3)

7. PARTNERS WITH FAMILY

Leaders are expected to be supporters and advocates of the family. Their leadership in a child or adults life does not end on Sunday morning, but they are expected to show genuine interest and care for the families they lead.

8. **<u>TEACHABLE</u>**

True leaders realize they will never finish learning and that they don't have all the answers. We must be willing to take advice, listen to constructive criticism, and prayerfully consider the input of others. We might not always agree, but if we fail to listen we hurt only ourselves and rob ourselves of another chance to grow. (Prov. 12:15; 13:10; 19:20)
